Construction on Boys' Home: The boys' home was already cramped with the house parents plus seven boys currently living there, but with three more boys coming in the near future, it meant for a very crowded place. Plans were made to build an extension room for the house parents. This meant funds would be needed for materials and labor. The Lord provided both through a construction team from the States who supplied not only these needs but came with huge hearts of love ready to pour out on the kids. It was exciting to see these guys and girls work together in the heat and dirt, starting the next phase to the home. It was also exciting to see the boys get right in there and work alongside the group as holes were dug and blocks were laid. It was a great learning experience for the boys not only in construction but in working together to make things happen. The addition was not quite finished when the team left, but another team has come to finish up the work.



Medical Clinic: The communities surrounding the orphanage are very poor and many live so far from the main hub of Managua that it is hard for them to get medical attention when they need it. The ministry is so blessed to have medical teams come, not only to minister to the children at the orphanage but to reach out to the local communities. We have been working with the local municipality in our area to go to locations that are in the most need of help. In the last month, several teams have come and reached out in such an awesome way. Long lines form and numbers are given out to see patients through the day. There's always a pharmacist on the team to fill prescriptions the doctors write. Children are given vitamins and other helpful things. These folks that give so much of themselves will

never know how much they have blessed the lives of the people here. Our own family has been blessed many times by these teams who also treat our medical needs.

Special Need: The girls are taking piano lessons and we are in need of a keyboard for them to practice on. We have priced them here and the cost is approximately \$300. If you would like to help with this need, we would greatly appreciate it.

Thank you for all you do for us as we labor on the mission field of Nicaragua.
