Greetings from the land of lakes and volcanoes! The past few weeks have been busy with many teams coming and going. One team from Pensacola spent a week doing medical clinics with the indigenous people in very poor areas. Many came to each clinic and were blessed to receive quality medical attention and needed medicines. They also experienced an outpouring of God's love and compassion through the medical team members.

On one rainy morning, we were in the middle of a clinic at a small coastal church when our translator received a call from his father telling us to get out quickly because a hurricane was hitting at that very moment. We don't get weather warning news like in the States, so we were unaware of the danger. All of the sudden, the roof started to lift up off the building and next thing we knew, a tree fell over on top of it. No one was hurt, so we quickly packed up and got in the bus to leave. Trees had fallen all over the road, making it impossible to pass, so we got out and used machetes to clear the road while all around us we could hear the cracking sounds of trees getting ready to fall. Someone shouted, "Run!" and we all did as trees fell all around us. It took about three hours to get back out to the main road. Truly God's hand of protection was upon us all.

Another team from San Marcos, Texas came and spent a week doing evangelism in schools, feeding programs and praying for the needs of people in hospitals. They were also a great blessing to the children at the orphanage as they spent time playing with the toddlers and holding the babies. We appreciate all those who have come to be a blessing to the people of Nicaragua!
