Happy Valentine's Day! I hope that all of you are doing well. I am recovering from the surgery I had on January 22 (thanks for praying!). I'm doing really good, just still pretty tired and can't do all I'd like to do as fast as I'd like to do it...of course, it's only been three weeks! (I'm an "impatient patient"!)

Please pray that I get my energy back soon so I can get finished with the things I need to work on.

Nicaragua trip - The medical missions trip to Nicaragua for March was cancelled. I could never get a clear "OK" from the Lord, so I had just decided that I was not going...then found out that it was cancelled. The Lord just kept closing doors, so they felt that they were not to go at this time. They are hoping to go sometime this summer, so if they go after I move to Nicaragua, I may be able to join them.

What will I be doing next??? - I will be in Oneonta, Alabama (north of Birmingham) until around the first or second week of March, continuing to recover and trying to work on some of the many things I need to do. I have been here since the end of November, and have really enjoyed the opportunity to get to know the people in the church (Cornerstone Fellowship) better. The pastor and his wife, David and Lucy Wilson, and I have known each other since soon after I was saved in Lucy's parents' church in Tuscaloosa, Alabama (it was 1972, I was seventeen, and a very mixed up teenager!). Her parents, Joe and Wrae Fowler, prayed for me (a lot!), let me hang out at their house (a lot!), and taught me much concerning right relationship with the Lord and walking with Him. They retired several years ago and moved back to Oneonta, so it has been a special blessing to be able to spend some time with them, too.

Around the first or second week of March, I'll be back in Tuscaloosa for a couple of weeks before driving to Pensacola, Florida. This is where my mission


board is located, and where I lived for a few years in the early 80's before going to the mission field. I plan to stay there (except for some short trips) until just before I leave for Nicaragua in July, finishing up the things I need to do and spending time getting back in touch with old friends that I haven't had time to visit with in years!

I'm parked on their property and they have made me feel like "family". They also let me stay in their house after surgery until I felt like moving back out to the RV. Thank you so much! I also plan to make some short trips to visit churches, supporters and friends (North/Central Florida; Mississippi/Arkansas; and Virginia/North Carolina/South Carolina/Georgia) during this time.
