Hi Everybody!

Big Surprise...it seems we're moving again!!! - Yes, that's right...before I could get completely UNPACKED and sorted, I'm packing up to move again. Joy Pulsifer, who runs the children's home for the older children and teenage girls in Jinotega talked with Sandy Carter (founder and director) and, after getting her approval, asked me to move there to work with her. After quite an elaborate, well-thought-out and executed "sales pitch" (she was really cute and quite comical!), I agreed to pray about it for a couple of days and let her know my decision. I emailed many of you and asked for prayer...*thank you so much for praying!*

Later, I told Joy that it was like the Lord had been getting all the puzzle pieces together, then suddenly put it together...or suddenly hit the "total" key and it all added up. The first two times I went to the Jinotega children's home was several years ago, soon after it opened. Both times, I remember sensing I'd "be there" for a while "someday." When I went up in July of 2007, I had the same thoughts. When I was there with the group in October, it was the same...I just didn't think it would be right now!

I've got a house! - I went up last week and rented a small house near the children's home (it's still not a good idea to try and buy anything). I'm almost packed up and ready to go, but I'm still trying to find someone with a truck to move everything. I hope to be moved by the end of this week or first of next week.

So where is Jinotega??? - Jinotega is located north of Managua, about three or four hours away. It is in the mountains and the scenery is beautiful. There is much coffee production in this area. It's a lot cooler. (Suzie will love it...I'll have to get used to it! I'm taking BLANKETS!)

So what will I be doing??? - I will be the "nurse," so I'll be taking care of dispensing medicines and keeping them organized, taking care of the kids when they are sick, updating medical records on the children and taking them to medical and dental appointments. I'll also be doing devotions and Bible studies with the children and

staff and working with the kids in outreach and evangelism (yes, that means puppets and other outreach tools!) I'll also help out with shopping and anything else that needs to be done. I'm very thankful that the Lord has made it clear what HE wants me to do...the details! It's kind of neat the way He worked it out!

Prayer Requests:

-- That I'll get UNPACKED and settled in smoothly and that my dog and cat and I adjust quickly to the move

-- That I'm able to fit in well with those that live and work at the Jinotega children's home (and that I'll learn names fast...names are hard for me.)

-- That I find a good, dependable vehicle SOON (I'm looking at some, but am waiting on someone to get back to Nicaragua that can help me make sure I get a good one at a good price.)

-- Anything else you felt led for to pray about!
