I'm **FINALLY** in Nicaragua! I arrived with dog, cat, and all my bags on Wednesday night, August 20. A big thank you to everyone that prayed...the Lord answered ALL the prayers and took care of **ALL** the details! **THANK YOU LORD!!!** We all three came right through customs with no problems!



I'm in the process of settling in and getting acquainted with the twelve little kids, nine teenage boys, and the workers that live here. I met some of them when I was here last summer, but others are new. We had a meeting yesterday with the teenage boys and sang some songs and talked about the Lord a while.



(my cat) is a little more shy and less sociable. He is adjusting to being allowed "outside" again.

Suzie (my dog) is a big hit with almost everyone. There are still a few that are a little afraid of her, but they **are** getting closer! Most of the kids (and the older boys and the staff) love her! She is **GREAT** with kids! She patiently tolerates little hands and some tail-pulling (they are fascinated with her fluffy, curly tail!). Tiger

This will give me more money for a vehicle here. Even at the price of gas, the RV was a **tremendous** blessing for me during the ten months I called it “home”.

### **SOON.**

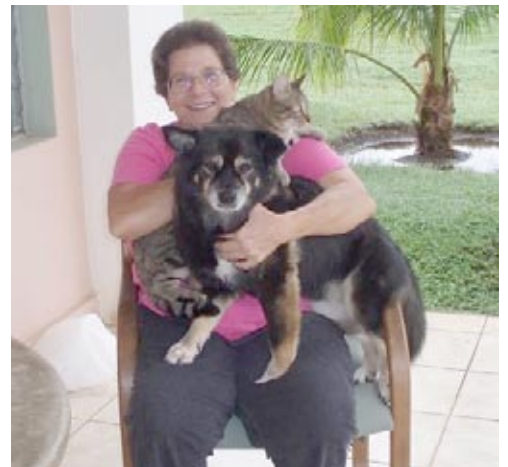
--That the Lord shows me ***exactly*** what to do concerning permanent housing.
