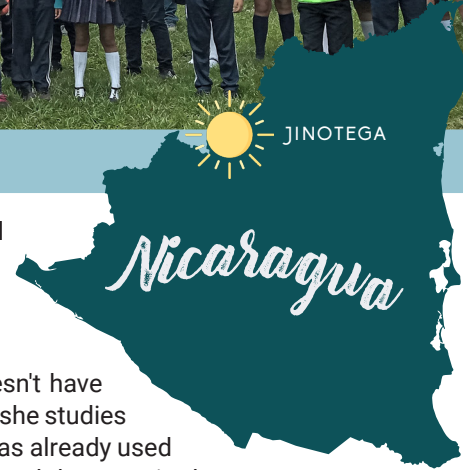




SANDY BRITNELL | CHILDREN OF DESTINY
